BIDDERS:

The undersigned bidder affirms and declares that he/she has carefully examined the specifications and the streets on which the work is to be performed, and will provide all labor, materials, equipment, supervision, insurance, permits and abide by all local, state and federal codes applicable to do the work in accordance with the specifications, plans, and the requirements under them to **resurface selected City Streets** for the following sum to wit:

IMPORTANT: Winston-Salem City Code (*Chapter 2, Article 1, Sec. 2-3*) provides that the City may disqualify contractors from bidding on construction contracts of the City if a contractor fails to perform satisfactorily on past or current projects. Failure to complete work within contract time limits and/or meeting required quality levels are factors that would make a contractor ineligible to bid on future City projects.

Satisfactory performance on a job includes: performing work to City standards (including all safety and labor laws), working cooperatively with our inspector and citizens, and completing the project in the time period provided for in the contract. Again, please follow all City and NCDOT specifications. **Failure to complete work within contract time limits and/or meeting required quality levels are factors that would make a contractor ineligible to bid on future City projects.**

Work items should include the following:

- Item 1.** Placement of approximately 55,069 tons of Winston-Salem Hot Plant Mix (State Super Pave 9.5B) per detailed specifications contained herein.
- Item 2.** Milling of approximately 505,311 sq. yards of pavement at a minimum depth of 1" to depth approved by City Paving Inspector.
- Item 3.** 3,868 tons of Liquid Asphalt Binder, PG64-22, for 9.5B Plant Mix.
- Item 4.** 505,311 sq. yards of single seal

The Thermoplastic Striping requirements are identified in the complete bidding document

The City of Winston-Salem will award a contract to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder based on the total cost of items in the bidding document. **Work is to begin tentatively in May 2018. All work on priority routes are to be completed without interruption, except for inclement weather by November, 2018. All work on other routes are to be completed by June 2019.**

The City reserves the right to reject all bids or any portion of any bid they deem necessary for the best interest of the City, to accept any item or group of items unless qualified by the bidder, to acquire additional quantities at prices quoted on the Bid Form.
