

RE-ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Three bids were not received as required by North Carolina bidding law, so this project is being re-advertised.

Pursuant to N.C.G.S. 143-129, sealed bid proposals endorsed “**Miller Park Phase I Improvements – FB1885**” will be received by City/County Purchasing, 101 N. Main Street, Winston-Salem, NC until **2:00 PM, November 14, 2017** in Room 16 when all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. The City reserves the right to waive any informalities and to reject any or all proposals. Contractors must be properly licensed as required by Chapter 87 of the N.C. General Statutes.
